

# Retreat in Daily Life: Breakfast on the Beach

We'll need a name and contact number, and by signing up you agree to us storing your information on a secure computer.

We will let you know who your prayer partner is and who you can contact if you need more help.

If you sign up, you are agreeing to pray for 20 minutes a day, for 7 weeks from 30th May to 11th July and there will be material to help with praying. It is more about listening to God than asking Him for things, so it fits with the church spending time discerning God's will.

The first week's Notes are below, to give you a taste of RIDL.

# Week 1: So, what just happened?

# John 21:1-3

Afterward Jesus appeared again to his disciples, by the Sea of Galilee. It happened this way: <sup>2</sup> Simon Peter, Thomas (also known as Didymus), Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples were together. <sup>3</sup> "I'm going out to fish," Simon Peter told them, and they said, "We'll go with you." So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.

#### **Lectio Divina**

In this exercise you should find a Bible passage (see below) and read it slowly, two or three times, to let its meaning sink in.

Think about what you have read, its implications for understanding Who God is, and who we are.

If a phrase or thought stands out for you, then think about what this means for you.

Listen to what God might be saying through this passage.

# **Possible Passages:**

Day 1	John 21 v 1-3	Gone fishing	
Day 2	Matthew 28:1-10	Why Galilee?	
Day 3	Luke 24 v 36 - 43	He is risen! How do I feel	
Day 4	John 20 v 24-29	Thomas – seeing and believing	
Day 5	John 6 v 67 -69	Do you want to leave?	
Day 6	Matt 4 v 18 - 22	The first fishing trip!	
Day 7	Mark 1 v 35-39	"Everyone is looking for you.	

You can, of course, choose any other reading you like, as long as it is no more than about 10 verses long. If you find that one of the passages really speaks to you, then spend more than one day on it.

# **Churches Count on Nature**

Hundreds of churches have already signed up to a week-long 'nature count' occurring this summer, which will encourage people to visit churchyards and record what they see.

5-13 June 2021, is a citizen-science event covering churchyards across England and Wales.

The project will see communities and visitors making a note of the animals, birds, insects, or fungi in their local churchyard. Their data will then be collated on the National Biodiversity Network.
